

Slough Paint colours and Codes

(including some French cars)



This list has been compiled from several sources, and I've done my best to sort out those which are almost certainly the original colours from those which have been judged by restorers to be a close match. Your car has probably been resprayed during its life and the sprayer may not have used the correct colour so these may not match. Also, if it was resprayed some years ago the colour has probably faded a little so again, it may not match.

Regal Red: Rolls Royce Regal Red, 9500406

Pearl Grey (Gris Clair on French cars) AC126

Heather Grey AC121

Ivory (Ivoire on French cars). AC125

Close Match

Peacock Blue: Vauxhall Riviera Blue Starfire, Berger 6130 or Isuzu 702 Blaze Peacock

Mist Green: Citroen Vert Argent Metallic, Berger 5664

Silver Grey: Volkswagen Silver Metallic, Berger 5578.

Cars also came in Black and Airforce Blue.

The wheels often matched the bodywork. Pilote wheels were often cream, suggest try Renault Cream (340) or Trimate Paints Straw for stove enamelling.
